Prior Year Reporting (Spring 2021- 2022)

FTE for Undergraduate Enrollment: Number of FT UG Headcount plus Total PT UG credit hours converted to FT divide Total PT hrs. by 12)

FTE for Graduate Enrollment: Number of FT Grad Headcount plus Total PT Grad credit hours converted to FT (divide Total PT hrs. by 9)

Current Year Reporting (Spring 2023)

Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) for Total Enrollment = Number of full-time students + one-third of the part-time students.

FTE for Undergraduate Enrollment = Number of full-time Undergraduate Students + one-third of the part-time Undergraduate students.

FTE for Graduate Enrollment = Number of full-time Graduate Students + one-third of the part-time Graduate students.

*** The University reopened in Spring 2021 and only approved cohorts (e.g. New First-Time Freshmen, New Transfers, Graduating Seniors, and Student Leaders) were living on-campus.
