

What is Improve?

Improve is CAU's electronic assessment system which is to capture the University's annual planning and assessment efforts.

Improve is used to manage and document data results for continuous improvement with **Academic Programs**, **Administrative Support Services**, **and Title III Funded Activities**. It allows for the development of Action Plans and follow-up to align with assessment results. Improve also provides for customization of budget requests for objectives and outcomes link to continuous improvement.

ACCESSING Improve:

To gain access to Improve, contact the Title III Office. Improve can be accessed in two ways:




CAU's Annual Assessment and Improvement Six- Step Cycle




The process is outlined below:


- 1. **Define** Student Learning/Program performance outcomes
- 2. **Identify** assessment methods and tools
- 3. Establish criteria of Success
- 4. Collect and analyze data
- 5. Plan and execute improvement actions

Adding Assessment Methods and Criteria of Success




CRITERIA FOR SUCCESS


Establishes a specific indicator for accomplishment of the outcome/objective and overall target for the program/department's performance. Benchmarks should be utilized as a measure of success.


Example:


• At least <u>75% of the students</u> living in the resident halls will report a <u>level of satisfaction</u> with the overall experience at a 3 (satisfactory) or above on a 5 point scale.






Assessment: Program Four Column






