## Comprehensive Retention and Graduation Rates

Retention and Graduation Rates are comprehensive key performance indicators of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) student success. CAU tracks first to second-year retainment (Fall to Fall), as well as progressive retainment (first to third, fourth, fifth, and six-year). CAU has an Undergraduate Retention rate of 68% and a Graduation rate of 48%.
